This is a Christ-centered short-term emergency shelter

Re-Entry Partnership Housing Program



This program provides returning citizens (prison/jail) with stable housing and food

The Door Transitional Housing Program



This program provides structure, supervision and discipline to men who have substance abuse and mental health concerns.

Transitional Housing Offender Reentry



THOR provides temporary housing for working homeless men under supervision (parole or probation).

Douglas County Women’s Shelter



This program provides temporary housing for women and children. Single women - 90 days. Women with children - 120 days.

Living for Success Housing Program



This program provides housing to working men transitioning from homelessness that cannot obtain traditional housing due to credit and/or legal problems.

Veterans Restoration Housing Program



This program provides temporary housing and a support system within the community for homeless veterans.



This curriculum helps individuals develop effective goals that create a healthy balance between values, priorities and obligations.



This class helps build the skills necessary to increase their income, attain financial independence, and maintain housing.



This is a Christ-centered, 12 step recovery program for anyone struggling with hurt, pain or addiction of any kind.



The outreach activities help individuals and families' access needed support.
